Where iPhones falls short: critical safety gaps



Content Management

Anyone can contact the phone, and users delete texts — making it hard to spot dangers.



App safety & data Privacy

Teens can download apps without approval and share personal information with strangers.



Social media & mental Health

Apple Screen Time has workarounds. Heavy social media use increases anxiety and depression.

"We struggled with iPhones because texts could be deleted, the internet could be accessed, and all sorts of dangers presented themselves. Apple Screen Time just wasn't working."



- Reach out to past abusers
- Access OnlyFans and other risky platforms
- → Delete harmful messages
- → Use social media in ways that harmed mental health



Why the Bark Phone is different





Contact approvals so no one gets through without permission.



Real-time monitoring and alerts for selfharm, drugs, and more.



Texts can't be deleted from the phone.



Customizable features so you can add or remove features when needed.



App and screen time limits that actually work.



The Bark Phone can be stripped down to basic functions (talk, text, and camera).
