- Monitoring across 29 categories, including self-harm, bullying, predators
- Texts can't be deleted, providing full transparency
- Real-time alerts to help you create a safety plan and respond early to issues

## TWO

### Skill development

Learning independence is essential. Bark supports:

- Development of daily living skills with safer, guided device use
- Access to adaptive apps and a customizable interface
- Ongoing learning opportunities through parent-child conversations triggered by alerts

## THREE

### Empowerment & inclusion

Bark helps your child confidently connect with the world as well as:

- Communicate with their community, peers, and caregivers
- Use built-in GPS tracking to support both safety and autonomy
- Stay mentally well with alerts that can signal emotional changes

- 2 Submit a request to purchase a Bark product with your CLTS provider liaison utilizing Medicaid funding.
- 3 Once the request is received and approved, the product will ship direct.
